MEMBERS RIGHT TO SPEAK POLICY

For members that want to speak at the Board of Directors meetings:

The law, Florida Statute 720.303 2b, Says it's your right to attend and speak at your Board meetings.

The board can adopt written reasonable rules and regulations concerning the duration and frequency for members to speak.

We find it necessary to set these new limits so we can get through our business in our meetings.

(1) When the Board makes a motion on a subject and it is seconded, the Directors will discuss it among themselves.

(2) Then the members will be given their opportunity to discuss, ask questions and give their opinions on that subject. For (3) three minutes to each member.

(3) After that discussion period is over, the Board will decide to vote on the subject.

(4) Once a subject has been voted on by the Board, we move to the next subject and the previous subject will not be addressed again.

(5) After the Board covers all it's subjects on the Agenda, we will allow the members to discuss any previous or new subjects before we adjourn.
