MEMBERS RIGHT TO SPEAK IN ZOOM MEETINGS POLICY

For members that want to speak at the Board of Directors Zoom meetings:

The law, is Fla Statute 720.303 2b. It's your right to attend and speak at your Board meetings.

The board can adopt written reasonable rules and regulations concerning the duration and frequency for members to speak.

We find it necessary to set these new limits so we can get through our business in our Zoom meetings.

(1) The Board will open the meetings and follow the Order of Business through the Committee Reports.

(2) The Board will open the Zoom meeting to the residents and allow them to speak for (3) three minutes for each member. The member may speak concerning any Agenda item or they may speak for any other subject they choose. When this period has ended the members will no longer converse with the Directors in the meeting.

(3) After all members have spoken, the Board will continue to the Order of Business and undertake the subjects of Unfinished Business and New Business and Adjournment.
